

The apostolic spirit and educational mission of the community derives from the contemplation of the Heart of Our Lady cooperating with Christ in the redemption of man. The Founder encouraged the Sisters to meditate on an eighth sword that pierces the Heart of Mary at the sight of sin. However, instead of committing themselves to reparation for sin, as other communities did, the Sisters' mission would be to attack the roots of the evil by praying for the conversion of sinners and by working for the evangelization of society, especially through works of Catholic education.

In combining the devotions of the Sorrowful Mother with devotion to the Immaculate Heart of Mary, Fr. Masmitja focused on the role played by our Lady in the paschal mystery. Through her suffering endured in union with Christ, Mary was associated with the work of redemption. For a religious community, devotion to the Immaculate Heart has to be lived in the context of a life completely dedicate to God's service through the following of her Son, a life committed to hearing the Word and putting it into practice, of an existence consecrated to spreading the Gospel.
